Join us as we explore Racine, Wisconsin, known as the Belle City of the Great Lakes. We will tour some of the top industry leaders in the world. Many of the products you use every day in your home come from Racine.

Our first stop is at the Case-New Holland tractor assembly plant. Case manufactures the Maxxum and the Magnum tractors here. They are among the largest farm tractors in the world. We take a walking tour that will allow you to see these monsters being manufactured from beginning to end, viewing each step of the production. Watch transmissions moving down the assembly line, engines being painted by robots, windshields and huge tires being mounted on the tractors, to the final step of driving them off the line.

Lunch is at Spinnaker's Restaurant on the Lakeshore, overlooking beautiful Racine Harbor. **Please make your entrée selection with your reservation.**

The last stop of the day is at the SC Johnson Company Administration Building & The Golden Rondelle Theatre. The administration building, the largest commercial project designed by Frank Lloyd Wright, was completed in 1939. It has been termed one of the most advanced in modern architecture. The furniture was also designed by Frank Lloyd Wright to add efficiency and beauty. The Golden Rondelle Theatre was designed for the SC Johnson Wax pavilion at the 1964-65 New York World's Fair. After the fair it was brought to Racine and placed on a new base to complement the existing buildings of the SC Johnson corporate headquarters.
